




his family home is located in the heart of the Catskills Mountains, in New York State, on a plot that covers several hectares with spectacular views in the middle of nature. It is a mountain cabin with exteriors designed by the LANG architecture studio and interiors by The Brooklyn Home Company (TBHCo), for the family of TBHCo's managing partner, William Caleo, his four children and his partner. The complex includes a two-story modern design main house, a swimming pool and a pool house connected with a path through the forest that leads to a fully equipped leisure house. In addition to a blue stone pond and a guest house complete with a sustainable vegetable garden.

The entire design of the complex is based on **sustainability**, **nature and landscaping**. From LANG it was decided that the design of all the structures would connect with nature. The property also runs on solar energy, with Tesla chargers, a self-sufficient blue stone pond between the guest house and the main house. The family also maintains a three-season vegetable garden that they regularly use for their meals.
